Sparkling Wines & Champagne

Louis Roederer Cristal

\$500

Cristal was first created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II of Russia. Convinced he was to be assassinated, he ordered the bottles be made clear, to prevent hiding a bomb within -- and this Champagne has been known as Cristal ever since. Only about 350,000 bottles are available yearly worldwide.

Dom Pérignon

\$300

Sparkling wine made in the tradition of Benedictine monk Dom Pérignon (who perfected the art in the Champagne region of France) has its origin in 1921 by Moët & Chandon company, who always blends Chardonnay and Pinot Noir to come up with the distinctive taste.

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut

\$130

Delicate Chardonnay and strong Pinot Noir blend harmoniously with Pinot Meunier, a complex variety that reveals all its qualities when selected with care. White flowers, white fruit, pineapple and grapefruit. The light, delicate Grand Brut offers a wide range of flavours. A fresh, lively, dynamic and perfectly balanced wine to be enjoyed as an aperitif and at any time of day.

Moët & Chandon Impérial

\$130

Established by wine trader Claude Moët in 1743, the reign of King Louis XV increased demand for sparkling wine; but it was Napoleon who truly increased the company's product. Imperial was first introduced in the 1860s.

Tito's Handmade Vodka

\$350

Tito's Vodka is produced in Austin Texas from the first legal distillery in the State. Produced with yellow corn (as opposed to the more common wheat or potatoes), distilled six times, and possessing a mildly-sweet aftertaste, Tito's has routinely beat "more expensive" vodkas in taste testing competitions.

Grey Goose

\$350

Grey Goose is made from winter wheat grown in Picardy France. The distillate is then sent to Cognac where it is blended with calcium-rich natural spring water, then filtered through a copper filtration system that imparts additional flavor. Winner of the 1998 Best Tasting Vodka Award from the Beverage Testing Institute.

Ketel One

\$275

Ketel One is a Dutch vodka named after the copper pot still that it's distilled in (the first pot is "Distilleerketel #1"). Created from 100% wheat, it is filtered over loose charcoal and rests in lined tanks until ready for bottling.

Absolut

\$275

Absolut, the world's #1 vodka by volume sold, is a Swedish vodka made from winter wheat. Established in 1879, the spirit was introduced to global markets in 1979, and has been joined by other "flavors" since 1986. Absolut flavors are also available upon request.

Vodkas are offered with three complimentary cans of Red Bull flavors (choices include Original, Sugar Free, Blue Edition, Red Edition, Yellow Edition, Orange Edition, Silver Edition)

Whisky

Johnnie Walker Blue Label \$900

Johnnie Walker Black Label \$350

Originally known as Walker's Kilmarnock Whisky, the Johnnie Walker brand is a legacy left by John "Johnnie" Walker after he started to sell whisky in his grocer's shop in Ayrshire, Scotland. Johnnie Walker is the most widely distributed blended Scotch whisky in the world. Black Label is aged for 12 years, while Blue Label has no aging -- but is renown for its smoothness.

Maker's Mark \$300

Production of Maker's Mark Bourbon began in 1954, complete with its trademark wax seal bottles. No rye is used in Maker's Mark, simply a blend of corn, barley and red winter wheat. Rotating the barrels between the upper warehouse and lower warehouse in Loretto, Kentucky evens out the flavor, as temperature variation is minimized.

Tequila

Patron Gran Platinum \$800

Patron Silver \$350

Patron was the first of the "Ultra Premium Tequilas" -- created to appeal to vodka-drinking nightclub guests. It is made from the "Maguery" (or heart/core) of the agave plant. Patron Silver is known for it's smooth taste and easy drinkability; Patron Gran Platinum exceeds expectations as the "smoothest sipping tequila in the world."

Gin

Bombay Sapphire \$300

Triple distilled using a carterhead still, Bombay Sapphire is then passed through a mesh/basket containing the ten botanicals (almond, lemon peel, liquorice, juniper berries, orris root, angelica, coriander, cassia, cubeb, and grains of paradise).

Tanqueray \$225

Created as a London Dry Gin, Tanqueray is currently produced in Scotland. The botanicals infused with the spirit are a closely guarded secret, but are known to include juniper, coriander, angelica root and liquorice. It outsells all other imported Gin in the United States.

Well Gin \$150

Rum

Captain Morgan Spiced Rum \$250

Made with molasses, water, mash and yeast, Captain Morgan is distilled from sugar cane in a continuous still. Once distilled, the clear spirit is aged in oak barrels for up to a year, adding a golden color and character to the rum before the flavors and spices are added. The brand's taste is achieved through a proprietary recipe, which is blended into the rum mixture at the final stages of production, making use of spices indigenous to the Caribbean Islands.

Bacardi \$250

Originally created in Cuba since the Cuban war for independence from Spain, Bacardi Rum is now made in Puerto Rico, having been exiled from Cuba after the communist revolution. Using the bat as a symbol for good luck, the company has remained private for 150 years.

Well Rum \$150

All bottles of spirits are offered with three carafes of your choice of juices, three bottles of your choice of soft drinks (Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite, or Coke Zero), and fruit garnish.
